Now that the Christmas season is over, we have a wonderful opportunity to share the blessings God has given us with those less fortunate. **CARITAS,**Congregations Around Richmond Involved To Assure Shelter, is Richmond's largest and most inclusive homeless shelter. Over 185 participating congregations provide shelter, food, and necessities

on a weekly basis to individuals and families in need of immediate assistance. Continuing in our mission to be community-minded and globally-focused, Fairmount will be hosting CARITAS February 9-16.

The areas around the Family Life Center will be our guests' home during this week and we'll provide overnight shelter, dinner, breakfast, bag lunches, showers, and laundry services for approximately 30 homeless guests (mostly women and children). This will be Fairmount's twenty-sixth year of hosting the CARITAS program.

For our week to be successful, it will require a *team effort* from our church family and the community as we donate needed items and volunteer our time. Fairmounters have donated a total of more than 12,500 service hours to this worthy cause. This is a great opportunity for classes, groups, families, and youth to get involved.
